## WHO ARE WE & WHAT DO WE DO?

**Women on Site** is a registered nonprofit organization that hosts networking and social events for women and non-binary people in the construction, manufacturing, and building science industries.

While there are efforts by the government, and educational businesses. unions. institutions to recruit more women into our industries, the same cannot be said for the efforts to keep us once we're in. Few organizations offer resources or opportunities to build relationships with people who have had similar experiences, challenges, and that familiar feeling of being the "only one" on site.

#### ISOLATION IS ONE MAIN REASON THAT 44% OF WOMEN WORKING IN CONSTRUCTION HAVE SERIOUSLY CONSIDERED LEAVING THEIR JOBS. INSTITUTE FOR WOMEN'S POLICY RESEARCH

So, while recruitment is important, WOS is tackling the **labour shortage** issue we're facing through a different perspective: **retention**. And we're achieving this through community and connection.

Women on Site is the only organization run **by women on site, for women on site** in Canada.
